


29) On the Monte Piana – on the tracks of the World War I

At a quick view: Lago d'Antorno – Bosi hut– Monte Piana – Monte Piano – Malga Rinbianco – Lago d'Antorno

Starting point	parking Lago d'Antorno
Difference in altitude	Ca. 670 m
Highest point	Monte Piano (2.305 m)
Length of trail	Ca. 12 km
Time of walking	Ca. 2-3 hours

Huts	Malga Rinbianco, <u>Rifugio Bosi</u>

Description of the way: From the Berghotel we drive by car to Lago d'Antorno. Our tour begins on trail no. 122 and leads us to the Bosi Hut on the southern summit of Monte Piana. On the summit plateau we enjoy the breathtaking panoramic view of the world-famous Three Peaks and many other Dolomite mountains, but at the same time the numerous war relics remind us of the cruel mountain war. We take trail no. 6A and after a short while we reach a crossroads. Path no. 6 turns left and leads us to the north summit of Monte Piano. The descent is on path no. 6 until we reach the crossroads. There we continue on path no. 111 and descend via the Rinbianco valley.



Panorama: a place with lots of history and due to its perfect position, there are wonderful views to the North walls of the 3 Cime

Indications: you can also reach the <u>Rifugi</u> <u>Bosi</u> from the Misurina Lake at the back side by jeep (starting 100 m on the road to the 3 Cime) or descending from the south peak to the <u>Bosi hut</u> (total ³/₄ h).

With this tour you enter directly in one of the "hottest" places of **World War I** in the Dolomites
