

29) On the Monte Piana - on the tracks of the World War I

Starting point: parking place before the Landro Lake in front of the [Hotel Tre Cime](#), 12 km from Dobbiaco

At a quick view: Valle di Landro – parking – via dei turisti – Monte Piana summit – via dei pionieri – Valle della Rienza – parking place

Difference in altitude: 1047 m up and down

Highest point: Monte Piana South peak 2324m

Time of walking: 6-7 hours (parking place at the lake Landro to the M. Piana 2,5 - 3 ore, return 1 ½ - 2 ore)

Trail: From the parking place way 6b and then way 6a to the south pinnacle (Touristensteig). Return on way nr. 6 (Pioniersteig).

Huts: [Albergo Tre Cime](#), [Rifugio Bosi](#)

Variant: from the Antorno Lake path 122 to the [Bosi hut](#) – historic circle crossing both summits and descent in the Rimbianco valley on path 111 – ca. 450 m – 5 hours

Description of the way: From the Berg hotel you can take the car to the car park Höhlensteintal (1406 m) opposite the Hotel Drei Zinnen. Our tour begins on the tourist path no. 6A, which branches off to the left and leads over the scree of Schluderbach. A little later the path becomes steeper, and here you can already see the first war relics of the mountain war. Above the timber line, our hike takes us along a narrow path nestled close to the steep rock faces to the high plateau of the southern peak. On the summit plateau we enjoy the breath-taking panoramic view of the world-famous Three Peaks and of many other Dolomite mountains, but at the same time the numerous war relics remind us of the cruel mountain war.

Physical requirements: a medium long and pretentious tour where you need equilibration and not to be high shy, partly via ferrata, you need **complete via ferrata equipment!!!**

Panorama: a place with lots of history and due to its perfect position, there are wonderful views to the North walls of the 3 Cime

Indications: you can also reach the [Rifugi Bosi](#) from the Misurina Lake at the back side by jeep (starting 100 m on the road to the 3 Cime) or descending from the south peak to the [Bosi hut](#) (total ¾ h).

With this tour you enter directly in one of the "hottest" places of World War I in the Dolomites
