

## **Description of the way:**

10 km

From the Berghotel (1370 m) you walk to the church of Moso where you go right and continue towards the fire station. After about 100 meters you pass the bridge, turn left and walk through the meadows to the valley station of the cable car of Croda Rossa (about 20 minutes). With the cable car, you ascend to Prati di Corda Rossa (1950 m). Path no. 15 leads through meadows and forests and under the rocks of the Croda Rossa, Cima Nove and the Arzalpenkopf towards the Passo Monte Croce. Throughout the route, remnants from World War I can be seen, especially on the Monte Arnese, which is riddled with caverns and tunnels from the interwar period. Through a short descent near the ski slope, you descend to Passo Monte Croce (1636 m). From

there, you gently descend along trail no. 13 A to the "Signaue" and finally return directly to the starting point via the Sesto Circular Trail on path no. 1.

## **Advices and suggestions:**

This is an easy but very nice hike, where you have the possibility to half it, going back by bus from the Passo Monte Croce. Many visible residuals from World War I.
